We will be studying the comic book artist and founder Stan Lee and writing our own comic strips using his characters.

We will be creating our own superhero character and writing a description about them.

We will be creating our own onomatopoeia comic words and slogans in the style of the pop artist Roy Lichtenstein.

We will also be writing about a real-life superhero that we know and explaining why we think they are a hero to us.

We will look at pop art advertisements and write our own adverts for super hero accessories!

We will be creating our own super hero comic strips based on the artists Stan Lee and Roy Lichtenstein.



Art and Design



We will be using a range of media to make our own superhero handprint art

We will be learning about composition and proportion when creating our own superhero cityscapes

We will be learning about shading and toning when using a range of different art pencils to show movement when sketching our comic book superheroes

We will use watercolour when studying the grunge artist Lora Zombie to create her superhero art work in her style

We will be using a range of sculpting techniques in clay when learning about the art hero Augusta Savage, a leading figure who fought for equal rights for African Americans in the arts.

We will learn about some of the world's most important musical heroes and learn about revolutionary music styles such as rock and roll, punk rock and the blues that changed music forever.

We will learn about the famous dancer and choreographer Martha Graham —how she revolutionized modern dance. We will create a superhero inspired dance in her style.
