- ensure excellent attendance (minimum 90%) and punctuality and inform the school on the first day of any absence
- avoid, to the best of our ability, family holidays during academic term-time
- make time to talk and listen to my child, discuss home study and recognise the effort and progress my child has made
- attend parents' meetings and school functions in which my child is involved, and any special appointments as required
- let the school know if there are any factors which may affect my child's performance
- support the School Behaviour Policy, including sanctions such as after-school detentions

### **Use of Technological Devices:**

Technology is important in our daily lives and as a central part of the education experience at Si Ri Panya School. However, we have to have certain rules in place to make sure that technology is being used safely and is supporting progress and wellbeing.

#### **RULES**

1. Mobile phones and smart watches which can make phone calls/have internet access are not allowed for use in school or in class unless specifically requested and supervised by the teacher. Phones which are brought to school so that students can communicate with families after school must be kept in lockers or taken to the office for safekeeping and picked up at home time.
2. Laptops are permitted to be used for educational purposes only.
3. Personal laptops, phones and smart watches with internet access are not allowed during Break and Lunch times.
4. Students are only allowed to use their school email address and account whilst on school premises.
5. Downloading of any materials or images which are not relevant to the lesson or curriculum is forbidden.
6. Accessing games or apps during lesson times is not permitted.
7. Taking photos of other students or the school without teacher permission is not permitted.
8. ONLY the school's TikTok or other social media accounts can be used to upload educational and/or promotional videos.
9. Students are not allowed to listen to their own music whilst working. ONLY a joint playlist created by the students and their teacher can be created and played via the teacher's computer during lessons but only if all students are in agreement that the music is on.

\*\*\*Please note that, due to safety reasons, students are not permitted to charge their laptops at school in order to avoid potential electrical issues and trip hazards.

Students are required to charge their laptops at home each evening. Power banks can be brought to school in case of a battery that does not hold its charge all day.\*\*\*

#### **EMAIL**

As a school we use Google Workspace for Education. In order for your children in Years 5 and above to access this platform, it requires us to create a school email address on their behalf (student.firstname.initialsurname@siripanya.com). Google Workspace for Education is a set of education productivity tools from Google including Gmail, Calendar, Docs, Classroom, and more used by tens of millions of students and teachers around the world. Students will use their Google accounts to complete assignments, communicate with their teachers, work collaboratively on documents and learn 21st century digital citizenship skills.

#### **SANCTIONS**

Misuse of technology devices and internet resources may result in disciplinary action. What is not allowed and the consequences of doing those things are outlined in the Secondary Behaviour Policy and explained to students in the Behaviour Traffic Lights, which are also on display in every classroom. Consequences can include warnings and behaviour contracts, discussions with parents and withdrawal from the classroom for repeat offenders and, in extreme cases, suspension or expulsion. The school also reserves the right to report any illegal activities to the appropriate authorities.

#### PHONES/SMART WATCHES

If mobile phones/smart watches are seen in use when not permitted, they will be confiscated until the end of the school day and stored safely in the School Office.

#### LAPTOPS

Students who break any of the above laptop rules or the more detailed agreements as laid out in the Acceptable Usage Policy will face the relevant consequences, depending on the issue.
